PLEASE DON'T CONTAMINATE.

See hints below on what can and cannot go into your cart.

THIS:

Place only items that are listed as acceptable in your cart.

NOT THAT:

Do not "Wishcycle" or throw anything you think might be recyclable in the cart in the hopes that the recycling center will catch it if it's wrong. This is considered "contamination" and hurts the program.

THIS:

Break down your cardboard and crush your cans.

NOT THAT:

Do not overflow the cart.

THIS:

You can recycle aluminum and steel cans only, paper products, cardboard, and #1 and #2 narrow-neck plastic bottles.

NOT THAT:

Do not include other plastics, other metals, aluminum foil, tin, glass, styrofoam, yard waste or food waste. No fencing or chicken wire, please.

THIS:

Clean your recyclables before you put them in the cart! Remove caps, empty recyclables of waste, rinse them if necessary, crush them and put the caps back on.

NOT THAT:

Do not throw recyclables in the cart the second you finish them without cleaning them of contaminants. Empty all liquids.

THIS:

Break down and crush your recyclables so they can fit loosely in the cart.

NOT THAT:

Do not force items in the cart or place items outside of the cart. They won't be picked up.

THIS:

Break down your cardboard and crush your cans.

NOT THAT:

Do not overflow the cart.

THIS:

Leave recyclable items loose in the cart.

NOT THAT:

Do not bag your recyclables.

RECYCLING REMINDERS

Here are **FIVE TIPS** to help you remember what can and cannot be recycled in your RANA cart and ways to save room.

1 CHECK THE NUMBER, CHECK THE NECK.

All plastics should have a #1 or #2 on them. Only narrow-neck plastic bottles.

2 CRUSH IT!

Crush all plastic bottles, cans, cartons and cardboard to leave more room in your cart.

3 LEAVE IT LOOSE.

Do not bag your items, and place loosely in cart.

4 WHEN IN DOUBT, LEAVE IT OUT.

Wishcycling increases contamination. If you're unsure if item is recyclable, leave it out.

5 DO THIS, NOT THAT.

Empty it, rinse it, crush it. Follow all of the guidelines and avoid contaminating your recycling cart by eliminating unacceptable items.
